

Rules of entry

1. Photographs must be in jpeg format with a maximum size of 10Mb. If your original files are larger than this, please keep copies, as we will need the original if your image is to appear in the calendar.
2. By submitting your image, you are agreeing for the image to be used in the calendar and on social media (royalty free) by both Malvern Town Council and Beacon Camera Club. By entering the competition all entrants grant to the Malvern Town Council the right to publish and exhibit their photographs in perpetuity.
3. Entrants whose photographs are one of the finalists or selected to appear in the 2022 Calendar grant to Malvern Town Council the further rights to publish and exhibit their photographs in print, on their website or in any other media in perpetuity. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses. While we make every effort to credit photographers, including in printed reproductions of their work, we cannot guarantee that every use of the photographs will include the photographers' names.
4. Entrants must not cause injury or cause any distress to any animal or damage its habitat, either deliberately or inadvertently, whilst trying to take a photograph. This includes the flying of drones, which should not be flown too close or too noisily to wildlife, or their habitats or nest sites.
5. Care must be taken not to damage Town Council land or property whilst taking photographs.
6. We are aware that digital photography affords image enhancement. You can enter images that have had spots, scratches or other blemishes removed. You can have worked on the colour or enhanced the image for the sake of the composition. You can also crop the image to improve composition.
7. Entrants must complete all sections of the online form. Online entrants under the age of 18 will need their parents or guardians to fill out the form. All contact will be made through the parent/guardian.
8. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted and no feedback on any entry will be provided.
9. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules and the Malvern Town Council reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time and in its absolute discretion, if the Malvern Town Council has reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules, acted fraudulently in any way or brings the Malvern Town Council into disrepute.
10. No more than three images can be submitted per entrant.
