## WEARING THE WHITE RIBBON

- WHITE RIBBON AMBASSADORS AND CHAMPIONS
  Ensure that at least one person in your organisation becomes a White Ribbon Ambassador or Champion.
- AWARENESS RAISING AND FUNDRAISING

  Hold an awareness-raising (and fundraising if appropriate) event each year.
- DISPLAYING THE WHITE RIBBON

  Show that you support White Ribbon by displaying the Supporter

  Organisation badge on your website, email signatures and in public places.
- Mark White Ribbon Day, 25 November, every year, using our resources.
- POLICIES AND GUIDANCE

  Have policies and guidelines in place that protect staff and support them if they experience harassment, abuse and violence.
- SIGNPOSTING TO HELP AND SUPPORT
  Ensure people know where they can get help and support by sharing information among staff, through signage and online.
