### **Operations Update**

#### Adam Lee Playground

The new playground equipment has been installed at Adam Lee playground which includes a new zipwire, climbing frame and accessible roundabout alongside the Pump Track.



#### **Bloom 2025**

The Operations Team have been hard at work keeping the town "blooming" over the dry summer months with hanging baskets and troughs brightening up areas of the town. The regular watering uses the rain harvesting system at the cemetery which recycles the water.



Heart of England in bloom judging took place on the 17 July with the judges visiting various parts of Malvern Town from the Link Common, Malvern Cube, Great Malvern Cemetery, Victoria Park and the Adam Lee pump track. A small reception was held afterwards in the Park View Community Room at the Community Hub and the much awaited results will be shared in October.

#### Skatepark at Victoria Park

The contractor for the new Skatepark has now been selected and subject to the approval of the section 100 grant funding it is hoped that this new facility will open in spring 2026.
